The kindergarten classroom at Waldron Area Schools received \$1,475.79 to help fund new furniture, such as tables and bookshelves that have been damaged over the years. One table, if not moved correctly, loses a leg. The bookshelves are un-level, sagging, and are also in need of repairing.

"I would like to sincerely thank Michigan Community Credit Union for the Thinking Forward Grant, which will help our small school have safe and up-to-date furniture that we can be proud of!
